During the hot summer months, dogs have a limited capacity to deal with the heat, which can lead to heat stroke.¹

WHY IS MY DOG VULNERABLE TO THE HEAT?

Dogs can't release heat by sweating as we do, so their internal body temperature rises more quickly.²

WHAT ARE **SIGNS** OF **OVERHEATING**?

If you take your dog out during the summer, watch out for these signs and symptoms of heat stroke^{2,4}:



If you notice any of these signs, take your dog to the vet as soon as possible.

WHAT CAN I DO TO KEEP MY DOG **COOL IN SUMMER**^{1,5}?



- Never leave your dog alone in the car, even with the windows rolled down.
- Keep plenty of water available. If the water bowl is outside, keep it in the shade.
- Walk your dog in shaded areas. Pavement can burn your dog's paws.
- Take walks and exercise during the cooler hours of the day.
- Keep your dog inside when it's hot.
- Take breaks when exercising and make sure your dog is not panting too hard.

Heat stroke can be very dangerous for your dog but with the right steps, it is preventable!

If you're unsure how to keep your dog safe in hot summer months, talk to your veterinarian.
